

Proposed by-law change

Since the Judge Advocates position was voted into the By-Laws In January 2017, by the Membership, there has been NO interest in this position by any member of the Memorial rifle Squad.

The recommendation for the proposed By-Law change would be to place the duties of the Vice Commander and the Judge Advocate together as one office.

Article III Duties of Officers

Section 2. Duties of the Vice Commander are;

In the absence or disability of, or when called upon by the Commander, to assume and discharge his or her duties.

Section 13. Duties of the Judge Advocate are, to provide advice to the Memorial Rifle Squad Officers regarding contracts, protocol during official meetings and be familiar with “Roberts Rule of Order”, and the “Articles of Corporation”, “Constitution”, “By-Laws”, and the “Manual of Procedures” of the Memorial Rifle Squad, Fort Snelling National Cemetery.

With this proposal, it would remove Article III, Section 13, Duties of the Judge Advocate. And make Section 2 read, Duties of the Vice Commander/Judge Advocate.

This would make the Vice Commander and Judge Advocate one position, if passed, beginning in January, after the 2020 annual meeting.
